The LALIZAS 70177 is an inherently buoyant, children lifejacket and is approved for persons with a weight of 15 - 43 kg and a height of 100 - 155 cm.

Application/Limitation

Retro-reflective material and position indicating light shall be approved in accordance with the Marine Equipment Regulations.
